- B. **IMPORTANT!** Application for Certificate of Occupancy (CO) or final building approval for structures within the jurisdictional boundary (described as the area 500 feet west of the most recent CCCL) must submit a signed, written report from a certified electrical engineer that any exterior lighting is not directly visible from the beach, and that any areas seaward of the primary dune are not directly illuminated.

VERO BEACH SEA TURTLE PROTECTION PERMIT

This permit, when signed by the appropriate member of the Vero Beach Planning Department, certifies that construction activity proposed for the site indicated meets the requirements of City Code Sections 46-106 – 46-117, Protection of Sea Turtles. **Coastal construction occurring seaward of the primary dune during any portion of the nesting season must be conducted during daylight hours.**
