Background:

The City was approached by a citizen group with the concept of constructing a fishing pier at Riverside Park in memory of Cole Coppola who died in a tragic accident in 2014. Friends and family have formed a 501c3, the Live Like Cole Foundation, and have provided the matching funds for the Phase I FIND grant to design and permit the fishing pier. That process is underway and we are seeking a FIND grant for the construction of the fishing pier.

This application will be for funding of Phase II, which will include construction and CEI services. If we are successful in obtaining this grant we will advertise for construction bids in November, 2016.

Funding:

No funding is required at this time. The grant request is for \$156,000 and is a 50/50 match. The Live Like Cole Foundation has pledged to provide the matching funds.

Recommendation:

- Place this item on the City Council's agenda for March 15, 2016;
- Approve the resolution for assistance under the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) Waterway Assistance Program for construction of a Fishing Pier at Riverside Park.

Analysis:

Strengths: This project will provide another recreational opportunity at Riverside Park.

Weaknesses: None.

Opportunities: Approving the Grant request will provide a 50% match for the project construction and a citizen group is providing the matching funds.

Threats: None.
