


MacWilliam Park History

- February 18, 1944- County Master Deed, Purchased for \$11,170.58 in unpaid taxes.
- All of Government Lot 2, Section 31-32-40 less road right of way and Crawford property, Included Riverside Park and Beachland Elementary properties.
- June 1951- City accepts proposal from FDOT to grant land for new bridge and in return FDOT dredges and fills land between bridges to create "Wayside Park".
- 1952- Governor dedicates "Wayside Park" as Alex MacWilliam Park.
- November 1, 1954- Sold portion of Government Lot 2 to the Board of Public Instruction of Indian River County.
- September 9, 1959- Resolution 1028 passed by City Council setting aside that area lying 175 yards north of the old Beachland Boulevard for public park purposes.
- October 3, 1967- Resolution 1933 passed by City Council, whereas a baseball field was developed on the beach with the cooperation of the Babe Ruth League, the Pilot Club, the Los Angeles Dodgers, and the Beach Business Bureau, the new baseball field is hereby named and designated as Bob Summers Park in recognition of an outstanding citizen.
- Merrill Barber Bridge right of way was jurisdictionally transferred to city on September 20, 1996 and abandoned by city council on March 21, 2006





