

## **Notice of Availability of Water Quality Information Unregulated Contaminants Monitoring Results**

The City of Vero Beach has participated in the fourth round of study of Unregulated Contaminants (UCs) by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to determine the occurrence in drinking water of UCs and whether or not these contaminants need to be regulated. At present, no health standards have been established for UCs. HAA5 is regulated and the City does monitor for that on a quarterly basis.

The City will publish the analytical results for substances that were detected during the UC monitoring in its annual Water Quality Report. The following contaminants were detected:

Manganese  
HAA5, HAABr6, HAA9

No monitoring results will be included in the annual Water Quality Report for contaminants that were not detected during testing. In the interest of providing as much information as possible to our customers, we wish to inform you that the following contaminants were analyzed for, but not detected, during the course of our monitoring:

Metals:	Germanium
Alcohols:	Butanol, 2 Propen-1-ol, 2-Methoxyethanol
Semivolatiles:	o-Toluidine, Quinoline, Butylated Hydroxyanisole
Pesticides:	a-BHC, Chlorpyrifos, Dimethipin, Ethoprop, Oxyfluorfen Profenofos, Permethrin, Tebuconazole, Tribufos
