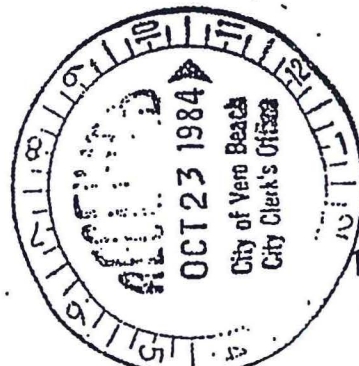
The Board of County Commissioners of Indian River County considered the status of the agreement between the City of Vero Beach and the County (South Beach Water Agreement) during their regularly scheduled meeting of Wednesday, October 17, 1984. The County Commission has reached the conclusion that it is not economically feasible to construct a subaqueous crossing to serve the South Beach area with the County's water supply. Please accept this letter as notification of the County's decision to transfer to the City 255 customers and the improvements associated with service to these customers. We have instructed our County Attorney to work with City officials to accomplish this transfer.

The Board of County Commissioners expresses its appreciation to the City of Vero Beach for its cooperation in providing service to the 255 existing customers and would encourage the City to provide additional service to the area.
