Welcome from the City of Vero Beach

The navigable waters of Vero Beach provide good holding and safe harbor for vessels transiting through or visiting the Treasure Coast. Whether enjoying the beach, shopping on Ocean Drive, or taking the free Go Line transportation service to town for provisions, Vero Beach offers many opportunities to relax and enjoy the hospitality extended by our community.

We recognize and understand that, from time to time, it may be necessary for you to leave your vessel anchored and unattended for a few days or perhaps longer. During that time, your vessel may experience adverse events in storms, dragging, interference from other vessels, casualty or other circumstances which may place your vessel in jeopardy.

Although Vero Beach does not specifically or regularly inspect or patrol seeking to identify vessels in jeopardy, nor does Vero Beach undertake such a duty, members of the boating community as well as citizens often advise and report that a particular vessel appears to be in distress and unattended. In those instances, the City of Vero Beach attempts to contact the owner of the vessel to advise that they need to check the status of their boat.

In many instances we are unable to determine who to contact to advise that the vessel is in distress and, as a result, some vessels have sunk or become a danger to other vessels. We therefore encourage you to call the City of Vero Beach Marina at (772) 978-4960 or (772) 231-2819 and advise as to the location of your vessel and provide your contact information so we can contact you if we are advised that there is a problem with your vessel.

Alternatively, please feel free to provide your contact information below and provide a copy to the office or fuel dock at the City of Vero Beach Marina. This is not a requirement for vessels anchored in the water of Vero Beach, but it will certainly be useful in the event that an emergency is brought to our attention.
